Dear Cattle Breeder

The Beutel families Warrillee Santa Gertrudis cattle are based at Bunburra 6 km south of Boonah. We have been breeding Santa Gertrudis cattle for 38 years with the stud being established in 1980. Warrillee cattle or cattle sired by bulls purchased from Warrillee stud have sold very well and have been awarded the major awards at all three Santa Gertrudis commercial show and sales held in the Scenic Rim region of South East Queensland during April 2011.

At Boonah show and sale on April 2nd Warrillee exhibited the Champion pen of heavy steers. At 18 months old they sold for \$850 and a pen of 15 month old Warrillee heifers were awarded Reserve Champion heavy heifers selling for \$790.

Trevor and Sue Whitehall from Mt Berryman who use Warrillee bulls were awarded the Champion lightweight steers with a pen of 8 month old steers who later sold for \$745. These steers were then judged Grand Champion pen of steers and Supreme pen of the Show and Sale. The Whitehall family also exhibited the Reserve Champion pen of lightweight heifers.

At the Kalbar Santa Gertrudis show and sale, held on the 9th of April Warrillee exhibited 1 pen of 16 month old steers. They were judged Champion heavyweight pen of steers, Grand Champion pen of steers and overall Supreme pen of the show and sale selling for \$820.

On the 30th of April the first annual Beaudesert Santa Gertrudis show and sale was held where more than 450 head of the region's best Santa Gertrudis cattle were penned. Warrillee exhibited a pen of 20 month old steers and a pen of 18 month old heifers.

In the steer section the pen of Warrillee steers were judged Champion Heavy steers and then Grand Champion pen of steers selling for \$885.

In the female section the pen of Warrillee heifers were awarded Champion Heavy heifers and then Grand Champion pen of females selling for \$1175 per head. The Grand Champion pen of Warrillee steers were later awarded the Supreme Pen of the show and sale by judge Andrew Macarthur. The three pens of Champion Warrillee steers were all purchased by Morgan Pastoral Co Dalby feedlot.

You have the opportunity to purchase some of this proven Warrillee genetics this year when 24 quality Warrillee bulls will be offered at auction as well as a number for private sale.

At the AG Show Bull sale on the 8th of September at the Toowoomba Showgrounds we will offer 8 classified S bulls 50% are natural polls or poll scurs.

All Warrillee bulls are vaccinated for 5 in 1, Lepto, 3 day sickness and have been blooded with 3 germ blood against tick fever. All are well muscled easy doing young bulls and will have scan results for eye muscle area and fat cover. The bulls will also be semen tested and are fully guaranteed for fertility. When buying a Warrillee bull we offer free delivery back to the Boonah area for your convenience.

We invite you to come and inspect our sale bulls and hear some informative speakers at a field day being held at our property on the 20th of August. We hope to see you at the field day or you are most welcome to inspect the bulls at any time. Please contact us on the above numbers.
